DON'T FORGET: Valnet patrons now have access to more e-books & e-audiobooks thanks to IDEA!

IDEA is a statewide partnership between the ICfL, public libraries and school libraries. This gives Valnet patrons can reach beyond Valnet's Overdrive collection and borrow titles from participating libraries which include Blackfoot Public Library, Cooperative Information Network, East Bonner County Library District, IDEA by ICfL, Idaho Digital Consortium, Kuna District Library, LIBRI System, Inc., LYNX Library Consortium and Meridian Library District.

Browse or log in with your library card to one of the following sites: valnet.overdrive.com or idea.overdrive.com (select **VALnet** as your library when logging in). Click on the 'Partner libraries' drop-down list (near upper right-hand corner) to select one of the participating libraries.

If using Libby, which is a free downloadable app, you'll need to click on the round Libby icon at the the bottom of the screen and then click "Add Library". In the next screen, type the name of the library in the search box (using one of the names listed above). Then choose "I'm visiting from another library" and enter your information.
